Important rules Crown Forestry request you adhere to during your visit to Waiuku Forest:

- Waiuku Forest is covered by a 365 day Prohibited Fire Season therefore fires are **NOT** permitted
- Strictly no access to Mine Area
- Keep out of area next to neighbouring rifle range (outlined in red)
- The use of motorbikes and quad bikes are **NOT** permitted
- Firearms are **NOT** permitted
- Access is not advised during strong winds
- Do not cut, fell or remove any live or dead trees
- All persons using the forests must comply with New Zealand law
- Always be courteous to other forest users
- Please take your rubbish home

Waiuku Forest Hazard Register

Hazard	Description
Mine site	Strictly no access to mine at all times.
Neighbouring rifle range	Keep out of area, outlined in red, at all times.
Hazardous trees (dying, broken tops, leaning, fallen)	Present anywhere in the forest, particularly along the coastal frontage.
Fences and gates	Erected across the entire forest.
Grazing cattle	Cattle can be present at certain times of the year.
Forest roads	Roads and carparks are open to public vehicles during opening hours.
	Drive to the conditions.
Other users and animals	Various users and animals can be present at any time.
Forest operations	Adhere to all forest closures when forest operations are taking place.
