The purpose of this Act is to—

- (a) restate and reform the law relating to how persons trade in food; and
- (b) achieve the safety and suitability of food for sale; and
- (c) maintain confidence in New Zealand's food safety regime; and
- (d) provide for risk-based measures that—
 - (i) minimise and manage risks to public health; and
 - (ii) protect and promote public health; and
- provide certainty for food businesses in relation to how the requirements of this Act will affect their activities; and
- (f) require persons who trade in food to take responsibility for the safety and suitability of that food.

Animal Products Act 1999

The objective of the Act is to –

- (a) Minimise and mange risks to human or animal health arising from the production and processing of animal material and products, by instituting measures that ensure so far as practicable that all traded animal products are fit for intended purpose; and
- (b) facilitate the entry of animal material and products into overseas markets by providing the controls and mechanisms needed to give and to safeguard official assurances for entry into those markets

Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines (ACVM) Act 1997

The purpose of this Act is to—
(a) prevent or manage risks
associated with the use of
agricultural compounds being—
(i) risks to public health; and
(i) risks to trade in primary
produce; and
(ii) risks to animal welfare; and
(iii) risks to agricultural security.
(b) ensure that the use of

agricultural compounds does not result in breaches of domestic food residue standards; and (c) ensure the provision of sufficient consumer information about agricultural compounds.

Biosecurity Act 1993

Law relating to the exclusion, eradication, and effective management of pests and unwanted organisms

Animal Welfare Act 1999

Establishes fundamental obligations relating to the care of animals. These obligations are written in general terms with detail found in codes of welfare. Codes contain minimum standards which have a legal effect under the Act for the care and management of animals.

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Food Act 2014 cont.

Risk-based measures: Part 2

Food sectors are classified into three classes of risk. Higher risk food businesses must operate under a Food Control Plan, medium to lower risk food businesses under a National Programme and very low risk businesses under neither (but still need to make safe and suitable food).

Food imported for purpose of sale: Part 3

This Part covers requirements for imported foods.

Provisions relating to recognition, territorial authorities, administration, and enforcement: Part 4

This Part establishes procedures for recognition of agencies, persons, and for their duties.

Miscellaneous provisions: Part 5

This Part includes provisions for regulations, standards, including Food Standards, and exemptions.

Animal Products Act cont.

Risk Management Programmes (RMPs): Part 2

An RMP is a programme designed to identify, control, manage, eliminate or minimise hazards and other risks during processing of animal material and products

Regulated Control Schemes (RCSs): Part 3

RCSs are special regulatory regimes to provide for cases where it is inappropriate or impractical to manage risk factors under an RMP, or where special provision is required for the purposes of overseas market access requirements.

Animal Product Standards and Specifications: Part 4

This part provides for the setting of standards and specifications that must be met by any animal product intended for trade or processed for reward, before it may be considered fit for intended purpose.

Export of Animal Material and Products: Part 5

The purpose of this Part is to facilitate export by providing for the specifying of requirements that must be met for products to be eligible for export; providing for requirements and systems intended to safeguard official assurances, and providing for the registration of exporters.

<u>Nutrient research</u> – find reports about projects on natural toxins, allergens, contaminants, nutrients such as sodium, folic acid, iodine and Vitamin D, and relating to the food residue surveillance programme (FRSP).

<u>Biological hazard research</u> – find reports from research into microbial hazards that are the predominant causes of foodborne illness. <u>Includes Campylobacter</u>.

<u>Production, processing, and handling research</u> – find reports from projects which concern the evaluation of meat hygiene, the safety of dairy, UCFM and produce products, domestic food handling, innovative processes and procedures, antimicrobial resistance and laboratory systems including the National Typing Database.
