





Information for Applicants — Matariki Tu Rākau

Matariki Tu Rākau is a partnership between Te Uru Rākau and communities to plant native trees to recognise the service of the New Zealand Men and Women of NZ Defence Force, past and present.

Te Uru Rākau will:

- meet reasonable costs of trees,
- pay for Matariki Tu Rākau branded signage or plaques, and
- in some cases, make a contribution to other expenses associated with planting events.

Applicants/community groups will need to:

- provide the land, which must remain publicly accessible
- arrange suitable trees and planting, and
- take responsibility to maintain the trees.

Application process

Te Uru Rākau will receive applications from groups that can meet the above. Applicants will need to apply in writing to Te Uru Rākau and include the following information using this form (next page) and any additional documents necessary.

Applications will need to:

- specify in detail the planting location;
- demonstrate they have freedom to plant (land ownership or permission to use);
- indicate community involvement in planting (e.g. Marae, schools, community groups);
- clearly outline number of trees required and any other costs sought;
- engage with their community and advertise opportunities for involvement;
- agree to install signage/plaque acknowledging the support from the Matariki Tu Rakau programme. Te Uru Rākau will provide wording or plaques for significant plantings and meet costs to install plaques.
- Publicise your initiative and acknowledge support from Te Uru Rākau through the Matariki Tu Rākau programme (a guide sheet and templates are available to help with this).

Payment Terms

Payment for approved applications will be following receipt of an invoice detailing the actual costs of trees and planting (not exceeding the approved amount). If this is an issue for your organisation, please let Te Uru Rākau know at the time of application.
