NOTICE UNDER THE BIOSECURITY ACT 1993

SECTION 131 - DECLARATION OF CONTROLLED AREA AND NOTICE OF MOVEMENT CONTROLS AND PROCEDURES IN RESPECT OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY - Bactrocera tryoni

Commencement

This Declaration and Notice takes effect at 3.00 pm on 26 April 2019.

Controlled Area Declaration

- 2. Pursuant to section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby declare that the area described in Schedule 1 ("the Controlled Area") is the area that is controlled in order to:
 - (a) Enable the limitation of the spread of Queensland Fruit Fly (*Bactrocera tryoni*) (**QFF**), being an unwanted organism under the Biosecurity Act 1993;
 - (b) Minimise the damage caused by QFF;
 - (c) Protect New Zealand from an incursion of QFF;
 - (d) Facilitate the access of New Zealand products to overseas markets; and
 - (e) Monitor risks associated with the movement of QFF from parts of New Zealand where the QFF status is unknown.

Notice of Movement Controls

- 3. Under section 131(3)(a) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby give notice that, except with the written permission of an inspector or authorised person appointed under s 103 of the Biosecurity Act 1993, and in compliance with any conditions imposed by an inspector or authorised person:
 - (a) Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) that are in Controlled Area Zone A must not be moved outside Zone A: and
 - (b) Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) that are in the Controlled Area Zone B must not be moved outside Zone B; and
 - (c) Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) that are in Controlled Area Zone A, and things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) that are in Controlled Area Zone B, must not be disposed of by putting out for collection by rubbish or recycling collectors.
- 4. For the avoidance of doubt:
 - (a) Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) may be moved *into* Zone A from Zone B or from outside Zone B.
 - (b) Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) may be moved *into* Zone B, from outside Zone B, but not from Zone A.

SCHEDULE 1 - Description of Controlled Area

The following areas are included in the Controlled Area and subject to this Notice:

Zone A (red area)

Controlled Area Zone A is the area which has the boundaries described below, and is defined as Zone A in the map in Schedule 2:

- (a) Beginning at the intersection of Faulkners Road and Church Street;
- (b) Proceeding south along Church Street to the intersection with Rodney Road;
- (c) Turning south-east onto Rodney Road and proceeding along Rodney Road to the intersection with Queen Street;
- (d) Turning south onto Queen Street and then east onto Stafford Road:
- (e) Proceeding east along Stafford Road, to the intersection with Denby Lane;
- (f) Turning north on to Denby Lane and continuing north into Stafford Park:
- (g) Turning east along the northern boundary of Stafford Park until the high-tide mark of the estuary east of Waimana Avenue (the estuary):
- (h) Proceeding north along the high-tide mark of the estuary until Onewa Road;
- (i) Turning west onto Onewa Road and proceeding along Onewa Road to the intersection with Queen Street;
- (j) Turning south onto Queen Street and proceeding along Queen Street to the intersection with Faulkners Road; and then
- (k) Turning west onto Faulkners Road and proceeding along Faulkners Road to the intersection with Church Street.

Zone B (yellow area)

Controlled Area Zone B is the area which has the boundaries described below, and is defined as Zone B in the map in Schedule 2:

- (a) Beginning at the intersection of Exmouth Road and Sylvan Avenue in Northcote;
- (b) Proceeding south-east on Exmouth Road to the end of that road, and continuing in a straight line across the Northern Motorway (State Highway 1) to the Auckland harbour mean high water mark ("the shoreline"):
- (c) Proceeding to a point 200m out to sea from the shoreline:
- (d) Turning south and proceeding in a southerly direction, following a line 200m out to sea from the shoreline at all times, towards a point 200m south of the shoreline of Stokes Point Reserve;
- (e) Turning north-west, and proceeding in a north-westerly direction in a straight line until level with a point 200m from the shoreline at the end of Rawene Road, Birkenhead;
- (f) Proceeding in a straight line into shore to the end of Rawene Road;
- (g) Proceeding in a northerly direction along Rawene Road, to the intersection with Hinemoa Street;
- (h) Turning north-west on Hinemoa Street and proceeding through the roundabout to Birkenhead Avenue:
- (i) Proceeding along Birkenhead Avenue in a northerly direction, to the intersection of Birkenhead Avenue and Pupuke Road;
- (j) Turning east on Pupuke Road and proceeding along Pupuke Road until the intersection with Raleigh Road;
- (k) Turning south-east onto Raleigh Road and proceeding along Raleigh Road to the roundabout;
- (I) Continuing straight through the roundabout on to Exmouth Road; and then
- (m) Continuing south-east along Exmouth Road to the intersection of Exmouth Road and Sylvan Avenue.

Specific Properties in Zone A

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of the Controlled Area Zone A, the entire property shall be included in the Controlled Area Zone A.

Specific Properties in Zone B


Where a property is bisected by the boundary of Controlled Area Zone B, the entire property shall be included in the Controlled Area Zone B.

SCHEDULE 3 - Things subject to Movement Controls

Zone A

- (a) Zone A fruit and vegetables, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables, wherever grown, except for:
 - (i) leafy vegetables; and
 - (ii) root vegetables; and
 - (iii) cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
- (b) Packaging materials associated with Zone A fruit and vegetables.
- (c) Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees, wherever grown.
- (d) Compost and green waste that contains Zone A fruit and vegetables.

Zone B

- (a) Zone B fruit and vegetables, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables grown inside Zone B, except for:
 - (i) leafy vegetables; and
 - (ii) root vegetables; and
 - (iii) cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
- (b) Packaging materials associated with Zone B fruit and vegetables.
- (c) Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees grown inside Zone B.
- (d) Compost and green waste that contains Zone B fruit and vegetables.

SCHEDULE 4 – Activities not subject to Movement Controls

The following activities are not subject to movement controls:

- (a) Transport of material listed in Schedule 3 through Zone A and Zone B on State Highway 1 (the Northern Motorway), provided that:
 - (i) Transit begins and ends outside the Controlled Area (Zones A and B);
 - (ii) No stops are made within the Controlled Area (Zones A and B); and
 - (iii) The material is contained and / or transported in an enclosed vehicle.
