This email is to confirm our phone conversation this afternoon.

We discussed the delay in gazetting the Kahutara, Oaro (extension) and Tutaeputaputa mataitai reserves, that Minister Nash agreed to declare in March 2018, and that the delay was due to ongoing discussions between MPI and Parliamentary Council Office regarding how to gazette the Oaro (extension) and appoint Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for it.

fasked for your thoughts on gazetting Kahutara and Tutaeputaputa separately, while continuing to work on Oaro, and you agreed that this would be an appropriate course of action. I follow up on this with our Legal team.

We also canvassed the idea of changing Oaro into an entirely separate mataitai, instead of an extension, if this would speed the process of getting it gazetted. We agreed that if it looks like gazetting the Oaro (extension) is going to take too long, then I would discuss this idea with my colleagues. Potentially it would take getting the Minister's agreement.

I'll keep you updated on progress.
