s 9(2)(a) asked me to send you some notes about the process that MPI will follow, given the Minister's recent decision to approve the Runanga's freshwater mataitai reserve applications. Hopefully the below is what you need.

The three reserves are:

Kahutara: the lower reaches of the Kahutara River, excluding an area put aside for commercial eel fishers.

Tutaeputaputa: the lower reaches of the Tutaeputaputa / Conway River.

Oaro (extension): the lower reaches of the Oaro River, to be added to the Oaro Mataitai established by the Kaikoura (Te Tai o Marokura) Marine Management Act 2014.

I don't have a date yet for when the mataitai will become effective. I'm working on getting the areas gazetted; organising for the Minister to sign a formal letter to that the applications were successful; and also for the Minister to sign appointment letters for Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki. This may all be some weeks away, as we depend on Parliamentary Council Office (PCO) drafting the gazette notices for us. I will let you know what the publication date for the Gazette will be, once I have it. The mataitai will become effective 28 days after they are gazetted.

After the mataital are gazetted, MPI will organise a public notice to go in the Marlborough Express and Kaikoura Star newspapers, advising about the reserves. Again, I will let you know what the publication date will be, once I have it.

There are nine Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki to be appointed for Kahutara and Tutaeputaputa They are Ma-rea Clayton, Brett Cowan, Nukuroa Tirikatene-Nash, Sir Mark Solomon, Gina Solomon, Keepa Te Rangihiwinui Timms (Major), Debbie Walford, Jeff Reardon, and Taukiri Manawatu.

s 9(2)(a) will contact the Marae about any changes needed to the Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the Oaro mataitai. For now, the Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki will be the same as those appointed for the coastal Mataitai, plus Jeff Reardon and Taukiri Manawatu.
