Thank you for passing on, via s 9(2)(a) the message that the next round of consultation may begin on the Kahutara and Tutaeputaputa maitaitai proposals and the Oaro Maitaitai extension proposal.

Please find attached a draft public notice that MPI is placing in *The Marlborough Express* and *The Kaikoura Star*.

The public notice invites submissions about the fish stocks in the areas specified in the applications from persons who take fish, aquatic life, or seaweed or own quota, and whose ability to take such fish, aquatic life, or seaweed or whose ownership interest in quota may be affected by the proposed maitaitai reserves.

As *The Kaikoura Star* is a weekly newspaper, they require material to be provided to them a week in advance. I will attempt to have the notice published on Wednesday 24 February 2016, otherwise it will be published on Wednesday 2 March 2016. In either case, submissions will be due by Monday 4 April 2016. Both publication dates allow for the Easter break.

Please let me know if these dates do not suit.

Consultation details will also be loaded onto MPI's website [here](#), on the same date that publication in the newspapers occurs.
