

## **CTO Direction**

Equivalent measures for consignments non-compliant with VEHICLE-ALL

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTO Plants: 2017 0031

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d) (iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, , give the following direction for measures, different from those required by section 4.3 in the import health standard (IHS): *Vehicles, Machinery and Tyres* – VEHICLE-ALL, that may be applied to a consignment craft shipped by Sevenstar Yachts sourced from Florida in the United States of America (USA). The measures consist of

- 1. Full visual inspection of the craft by Sevenstar personnel, or their agent, prior to leaving the Florida port of departure in the USA, to check for presence of any Brown Marmorated Stink Bug;
- 2. Physical cleaning of the craft;
- 3. Treatment of all compartments in the craft with the 0.06% dilution label rate Talstar pesticide
- 4. Cabin is closed post-pesticide treatment to ensure pesticide retention
- 5. A certificate is provided with the treatment details;
- 6. Inspection by MPI on arrival.

All other relevant sections of the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL for vehicles and machinery sourced from the USA must be complied with.

This direction takes effect from the 18 October 2017, and may apply to multiple consignments of craft shipped as cargo sourced from Florida the USA by Sevenstar which are not compliant with the measures required by section 4.3 in the import health standard (IHS) VEHICLE-ALL. This CTO direction is valid for two years from the date of signing unless earlier amended or revoked.
