

## February 2020 NPPA Manual Reprint - Summary of Amendments

- Please note no species were added nor removed from the Accord list.
- The following paragraph was added to the Introduction:
 

'Species, in the context of the Accord list is considered to include all sub-species, cultivars, varieties and forms if that species (including genetically modified variants), unless specifically excluded. However a species is considered to exclude any hybrids of that species with another species, unless otherwise stated.'
- 'and cultivars' was removed from '*Cotyledon orbiculata* pig's ear'. All cultivars are included unless otherwise stated.
- '*Hieracium lepidulum* tussock hawkweed' was changed to '*Hieracium* (all species) hawkweed'.
- '*Myrica faya*' was changed to '*Morella faya*'. *Morella* is the more commonly referred to genus.
- *Cenchrus caliculatus* was added to the list of excluded species from the *Cenchrus* genus. *C. caliculatus* is excluded from the NPPA it is native to New Zealand.
- *Salvinia molesta* was changed to *Salvinia x molesta* to denote that it is a hybrid.
- The common name 'wandering Jew' for *Tradescantia fluminensis* was replaced by 'tradescantia'.
- Logos of the parties in the accord were updated in Acknowledgements.
