## Rodents, Insectivorous Animals and Dermoptera to France (Guidance)

## 1 Purpose

(1) This guidance document has been issued to accompany Rodents, Insectivorous Animals and Dermoptera to France (OMAR). This guidance document should be read in conjunction with that OMAR.

## 2 Specific guidance for the zoosanitary certificate

- (1) Depending on the species of animal exported to France, a CITES permit may be required.
- (2) With regards to Section II, the name and address of the premises of first destination means the premises which the animals will be housed in France. The registration number refers to the flight number of the airplane.
- (3) With regards to Section III, Clause, 1.1, the holding of origin means the establishment in which the rodents are being exported from.
- (4) With regards to Section III, Clause, 7, either the owner of the animals, the exporter or person in charge is to provide the declaration stating that "until their arrival on the French territory the animals described in this certificate will not be in contact with animals of a non-equivalent health status."
