# **ACCESS POLICY**

Access to Wine e-Cert restricted. Below is our Wine e-Cert access policy.

### **Public User access**

Public access to Wine e-Cert may only be given to users where they can demonstrate they belong to, or authorised to act on behalf of, a business that:

- Produces wine under a registered Wine Standards Management Plan (WSMP), or
- Bottles wine under a registered Wine Standards Management Plan (WSMP), or
- Exports their own a wine brand, made by another business under a registered Wine Standards Management Plan (WSMP), or
- Exports wine made by another business under a registered Wine Standards Management Plan (WSMP).

Access requests must be submitted on a WA13: Wine e-Cert Company and User Registration or Amendments Application form.

Users may be associated with one or more of the following access permissions:

The access permissions (or combination of permissions) determine which Wine e-Cert functions a user can perform on behalf of the business they are associated with.

#### **MPI User access**

MPI access to Wine e-Cert may only be given to users who are required to perform functions in the system as part of their day to day activities. This access may be extended to include users who perform Wine e-Cert functions on behalf of MPI.

# **WINE E-CERT ACCESS - AN OVERVIEW**

You may request access to Wine e-Cert in three easy steps. Once you are set-up, Wine e-Cert is accessed via the RealMe login service. The first time you login you will need to provide your Wine e-Cert Activation Key.

Register your Business and Users for Wine e-Cert access

### Has your business manufactured wine for export or exported wine before?

Yes: You can update your business's existing details and register new users

No: Register a new business and users details

Submit a completed <u>Wine e-Cert Company and User Registration or Amendments</u> <u>Form (WA13)</u>. Forms available from the MPI website (<u>www.mpi.govt.nz</u>). Send completed forms to <u>wine.query@mpi.govt.nz</u>.

# Create your RealMe account

Access to Wine e-Cert is managed via the use of RealMe

## Do you already have a RealMe account?

Yes: Great. You can use your existing account to login to Wine e-Cert

**No:** Create your new RealMe account from the 'Create an account' link at winecert.mpi.govt.nz . See the Create a RealMe login section)

# Access Wine e-Cert

Access Wine e-Cert for the first time using your RealMe account and MPI Activation Key

## Have you received your MPI Activation Key?

**Yes**: Login to Wine e-Cert using your RealMe username and password. Enter your MPI Activation Key when prompted. (see the <u>Accessing wine e-Cert</u> section).

**No:** MPI will email you your Activation Key once your Wine e-Cert registration is processed.

## REGISTER FOR ACCESS TO WINE E-CERT

You must apply for access to Wine e-Cert.

Complete a <u>WA13</u> form. Send completed applications to <u>wine.query@mpi.govt.nz</u> (we prefer email to help us process your application as quickly as possible), or post to **Wine e-Cert, Ministry for Primary Industries**, PO Box 2526, Wellington 6140.



Access to Wine e-Cert restricted. Please read the Access Policy for details.

If you do not meet the requirements of the access policy, you will need ask the wine producer for a copy of the export eligibility statement and any other documents authorising your shipment. Guidance for exporters of wine made and branded by others can be found on the MPI website:

You can register multiple users on a single application, however each user will require their own RealMe login.

### **COMPLETING A WA13 FORM**

Download the WA13 form from the MPI website.



If your business is already registered within Wine e-Cert, remember to complete box 1: Business Details, then only complete the other boxes if an amendment is required to those details within Wine e-Cert.

Applicants can only sign their own application forms if they have the legal authority to act on behalf of the wine business (e.g. CEO, Director, Owner, Winemaker, CFO and Quality Manager).

Send your completed application to MPI.

# **CREATE A REALME LOGIN**


Access to Wine e-Cert is managed via the use of RealMe. RealMe is a service supplied by the NZ government and NZ Post that allows you to access multiple online services with the same username and password. The service is designed to protect your privacy and security.

You must have a RealMe account to access Wine e-Cert. If you do not already have one, create one following the link on the Wine e-Cert login page.



You do not need to create a RealMe login if you already have one. For more information about RealMe see: www.realme.govt.nz/about-realme/


The Wine e-Cert login screen displays

Click Create your RealMe login




The 'Set up your account' screen displays.

Enter the required details.

**Click** *Continue* when complete.


You will receive an email from RealMe confirming your RealMe account details.



The Wine e-Cert activation screen displays.

If you have received your Activation Key from MPI, you can enter it now.

Otherwise **Click** *Cancel*. You will be asked for your Activation Key the next time you login using your RealMe login.



# **ACCESSING WINE E-CERT**

Access Wine e-Cert using your RealMe login. The very first time you login to Wine e-Cert you must provide your Activation Key before you can continue any further.

**Go** to <a href="https://winecert.mpi.govt.nz">https://winecert.mpi.govt.nz</a> in your preferred web browser.






If you receive an error message, check the URL is correct. Use <a href="https://winecert.mpi.govt.nz">https://winecert.mpi.govt.nz</a>.

You may also experience error messages if you have data from previous sessions stored in your browser history, such as cookies (a cookie is a small piece of data sent from a website and stored in your web browser).

The exact process to clear cookies is dependent on the web browser you use, but generally they are located from your browser's *History* or *Options* menu.

Search the internet for guidance specific to your browser. You do not need to download any software to clear cookies.

The RealMe login screen displays.

Enter your RealMe username and Password.

Click Login.



The very first time you login you will be prompted for your Activation Key. The Activation Key is a unique code that MPI will email to you if your Wine e-Cert access application is approved. If you have not already entered your Activation Key, the screen below will display.



**Enter** your Activation Key that MPI will email you once your access is approved.

**Read** the *Terms and Conditions*.

**Tick** the box if you understand and accept the Wine E-Cert Terms and Conditions of Use and Privacy Policy.

**Click** *Save* when finished. You will be returned to the Wine e-Cert login page. Repeat the login process again, and this time you will go through to Wine e-cert.



The Wine e-Cert home page displays. The exact items you see on this page and actions you can take will depend on your user role(s).

You are now ready to begin.

Don't forget to logout when finished to maintain the security of your company's information.
